

Thank you for purchasing a

Yamaha WR250R/X Billet Big Rack

Mounting is easy!!

- 1. Remove rear fender and flip it over. Use a step drill (drill up to $\frac{1}{2}$ " diameter on step drill) or small ($\frac{1}{8}$ "- $\frac{3}{32}$ ") drill to pilot the holes, then chase hole with $\frac{1}{2}$ " or 13mm drill bit. The rear fender is marked on the bottom side from the factory. If available use a step drill bit, they make a cleaner hole than regular drill bits.
- 2. Remove the four bolts with a 10 mm socket holding the tail light/ lower fender in place. (There will still be 2 more bolts farther rearward that will hold it in place, leave those in place) The four bolts removed are not reused.
- 3. Reinstall the fender and push the included aluminum spacers in place. They are 1/2" O.D. So they may require some force to push into a 1/2" drilled hole. A 13mm drill will give you more clearance for the spacers.
- 4. Bolt it all together with the Flat head 60mm long screws. Easy!

This rack is ready for the installation of a Rotopax Pack mount and or Givi Monokey Topcase Mounting kit. The locking lug will bolt to the rear most ¼" holes in the rack which are 1" apart. Bolt the 2 t-shaped lugs to the ¼" front holes about 9" apart. These Lug kits are available in a link to Amazon.com on the home page of Scaggsmotodesigns.com

Use the 2 5/16" holes about 2.5" apart in the center of the rack for mounting a Rotopax pack mount. Bolts are included with the pack mount. The round universal mounting flange that comes with the pack mount will not be used in this application.
